

Made of wood in Indonesia using traditional methods, Silolona is heaven on the senses. Underway or at anchor, you hear the creaking of the wood as she gently plys the waters from Phuket to Bali and beyond. The crew of Silolona will enchant with traditional music and song, particularly when getting underway. It's something that goes beyond a straight charter and into an experience.

The dark timber on the interiors combines with light trims to create a mood that cannot be replicated by fibreglass or steel. A series of distinctive suites, named and decorated for distinctive regions of Indonesia, give

charter guests a truly relaxing and cultural experience. Built to the standards of German Lloyd's Register of Shipping, *Silolona* also offers comfort and peace of mind. With a length overall of 50 metres and a beam of ten metres, there's plenty of room, down below or up top on the many sundecks.

Silolona also comes with a complete dive centre, plus snorkelling gear, kayaks, fishing equipment and water skis. But don't dwell too long on the high tech kit. Should you find yourself in Indonesia, Silolona's crew and owner will help you with ashore visits to learn more about the island kingdom, seeing it in ways that most people never do.

It should also come as no surprise that the on-board cuisine is something special. International dishes are plentiful, but so is the traditional Indonesian and Southeast Asian flavour. If you don't sample it, you will miss out.

Silolona has been around for a few years now, and the popularity of this boat and her capable crew must certainly be gaining ground – a second boat is in the works. Silolona can be chartered through major agencies, or directly. Set itineraries for Malaysia, Thailand, Indonesia or Myanmar are available, or the Silolona team can custom-tailor a charter that is out of this world.
